Notes:

NSRAA's cost recovery goal for Hidden Falls is 495,000 to 580,000 chum (3.96 to 4.6 million lbs) for the 2007 season. Cost recovery fishing will begin approximately June 25, although if sufficient chum show up earlier, CR will begin earlier. Based on past CR harvest results it is expected to take 80 to 100 boat days to complete the CR harvest. The schedule shows CR ending on the 21st of July but it could take longer.

Broodstock will be collected by seine net, pursued up to the bunt section of the net and hauled by the seine skiff to the barrier net where the chum will be rolled into a net pen or rolled over the barrier net. Approximately 100,000 chum will be captured and held behind the barrier net, with another 30,000 chum allowed to accumulate on the ocean side of the barrier net. The 30,000 chum will be let across the barrier net beginning about 26 July when eggtakes have utilized approximately 30,000 fish.

Kasnyku Bay will be closed to seining during the month of June as per Board of Fishery action. Beginning July 1 Kasnyku Bay may be opened depending on broodstock needed. Typically chum begin to enter Kasnyku Bay in late June and early July but these early fish are needed for broodstock in order to have the full span of the run represented in the eggtake. Therefore in July, Kasnyku is often managed for broodstock conservation and this will likely be true in 2007.

The calendar shows mid-week openings, but they will only occur if cost recovery and broodstock weekly goals are met.
