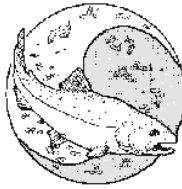

## **POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **HIDDEN FALLS HATCHERY**

**Title:** Maintenance Supervisor  
**Location:** Hidden Falls Hatchery (near Sitka, Baranof Island, Alaska)  
**Salary:** \$40,000 to \$55,000 per year DOE, plus housing and benefits  
**Open:** August 1, 2015 to September 3, 2015  
**Starting Date:** September 15, 2015

Northern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (NSRAA) is seeking qualified applicants for the Maintenance Supervisor position at Hidden Falls Hatchery, located at a remote site on the eastern side of Baranof Island, Southeast Alaska. Hidden Falls is accessible by boat or float plane only. The Maintenance Supervisor, under the supervision of the NSRAA Maintenance Manager and Hatchery Manager, will be responsible for the maintenance, operation and construction of hatchery support facilities and equipment. The Maintenance Supervisor is expected to apply their technical expertise to fish culture related hatchery challenges. Accordingly, this person will need to be a team player, and have good problem-solving and organizational skills. To be successful, the Maintenance Supervisor must be interested in learning about hatchery operations, and needs to be innovative, creative, and attentive to detail. Flexibility and adaptability are also important characteristics for this position.

The demands of this position are many and varied. Formal training, post-secondary education, and/or experience in certain skill areas are desirable. Prior experience and abilities with the following skills will be used to evaluate the applicant's suitability for this position:

- General carpentry, plumbing, painting;
- Welding (aluminum, steel, plastics);
- Electrical (12-24 volt DC, 120/240 Volt AC, instrumentation & control);
- Equipment repair and maintenance (diesel engines, outboard motors, small gas engines, hydraulic pumps);
- Ability to learn and manage a complex water delivery system;
- Refrigeration ;
- Heavy equipment operation;
- Small boat operation and seamanship;
- M.S. Office, Excel, networking and computer skills.

In addition, this person must be able to plan and develop cost estimates for maintenance-related projects, facilities, and equipment, and will be responsible for conducting preventative maintenance programs.

The position requires the Maintenance Supervisor to live on-site in housing provided by NSRAA. Job responsibilities include being on-site approximately 10% of the time after normal working hours for standby in order to respond to emergencies, and to provide hatchery security.

Hidden Falls Hatchery is operated by Northern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (NSRAA), a private non-profit regional aquaculture association. NSRAA provides increased salmon fishing opportunities for both commercial fisherman and sport fishing enthusiasts alike. Hidden Falls Hatchery produces one of the largest chum and coho salmon returns in North America, along with a large chinook return, making this hatchery one of the most economically important fishery enhancement programs in Southeast Alaska. Located in a remote setting in the heart of Alaska's Tongass National Forest, opportunities for outdoor recreation are unsurpassed.
